GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The abstract should be written in English. The text should be laid out for standard A4 (portrait format) paper without any style application. Font size should be 12pt, text font Times New Roman, width alignment, 1 line spacing. Only the title should be printed in capital letters. Specify the names and initials of the authors (underline the presenting author). If authors are from different institutions, the appropriate institution number from the affiliation list should be given as a superscript number immediately after each author's name. Affiliations should include institution name, address, phone, and fax. If there are multiple affiliations, each should be listed as a separate paragraph. The title, authors, addresses (including e-mail) should be center aligned. It is necessary to

make an additional 'blank' before the text. You should not print anything in the text in bold type. Latin plant names can be printed in italics. No tables, illustrations or photos. No references or citations. The abstract text should not exceed 1 page A4 (210 x 297mm) with field 2 cm. Only electronic versions of the abstracts are accepted. The abstracts will be reproduced without any editing.

The abstract should be sent <u>as an attached file</u> by e-mail to Alexander V. Nosov to the address: invitro2013@gmail.com until the 15th April, 2013. The file should be titled: surname_inicials_abst (for instance: smith_a_t_abst). If you send several abstracts, you must put the number after the last letter of title (for instance: smith_a_t_abst1 and smith_a_t_abst2). All abstracts should be sent as separate files. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to decline non-correctly arranged abstracts and the ones which do not correspond to the theme of the conference.
